INSTRUCTIONS This form must be used by one person only (or partnership). Writing MUST BE IN INK OR INDELIBLE PENCIL. Use one line only for each dog. The name of the dog and all the details as recorded with The Kennel Club must be given on this entry form. If an error is made the dog may be disqualified by the Committee of The Kennel Club. All dogs must be REGISTERED at The Kennel Club in the name of the exhibitor. If the registration or transfer of ownership has not been confirmed it must be applied for before the closing date of entries. In case of dispute proof of postage of such applications may be required by The Kennel Club. Puppies under 6 months of age on the first day of the Show cannot be entered for competition. On no account will entries be accepted without fees. If a dog is in the process of Registration or Transfer at the time entry is made, add the letters NAF or TAF as appropriate after it's name. Please put classes in numerical order and USE BLOCK CAPITALS throughout when completing this entry form. The Kennel Club Authority to Compete number (for dogs registered and resident outside the UK) must be stated or the entry will be returned. PLEASE CHECK ALL DETAILS BEFORE POSTING.

Your dog is vulnerable and AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm. Please take care of your dog. If your dog is found to be at risk forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.

I/We agree without reservation that any Veterinary Surgeon operating on any of my/our dogs in such a way that the operation alters the natural conformation of the dog or part thereof may report such operations to the Kennel Club. I/We declare that where any alteration has been made to the natural conformation of the dog(s) the relevant permission to show has been granted by the Kennel Club.

I/We further declare that I believe to the best of my knowledge that the dogs are not liable to disqualification under Kennel Club Show Regulations.

<u>SHOW SETUP & BREAKDOWN.</u>	<u>Actions to be taken to reduce risk.</u>
Risk of injury due to incorrect lifting and handling during ring, exercise area, and stall setup and breakdown.	Advise helpers of correct techniques/ Provide tools & equipment.
Risk of trestle table collapse. Risk of blocked Fire Exits.	Check tables used are in good order. Check Fire Exits after setup & before Show starts.
Risk of fire at the venue.	Check provision of Fire Blankets in the kitchen, and of Fire Extinguishers throughout.
Risk of illness.	Kitchen staff to observe strict food hygiene standards.
<u>DURING THE SHOW.</u>	<u>Actions to be taken to reduce risk.</u>
Risk of trips & falls.	Check that ring surface is clear of obstructions/potholes. Check regularly that corridors, walkways and Fire Exits do not become obstructed. Check regularly for slippery floor surfaces, and mop if necessary.
Risk of injury to hound, handler and ring officials.	Safe showing of hounds will be encouraged by all officials.
Risk of Bio-hazard from dog excreta.	Provide "pooh bags" and advise dog owners to use them by notices prominently posted. Check regularly for "accidents".
Risk of dog bite.	Dogs should be under control at all times. Non-owners will be advised by notice not to approach dogs in cars whether attended or not. Non-owners will be advised by notice to seek permission before approaching dogs under control.
Risk to dogs in cars.	Owners are reminded of this risk in the catalogue.
Risk of illness to those attending the show.	Ensure that a qualified First Aider is present. Know where an emergency telephone is located. Know where a First Aid Kit is located.
Risk of illness to dogs attending the show.	Veterinary Surgeon on call as advised in the schedule and catalogue. Directions to find Vet's surgery are provided in the Show catalogue.
